

## Junior Assistant Scoutmaster

### Job Description:

The Junior Assistant Scoutmaster serves in the capacity of an Assistant Scoutmaster except where legal age and maturity are required. He is appointed by the Scoutmaster because of his demonstrated leadership ability.

**Reports to:** The Scoutmaster

**Adult Mentor:** Scoutmaster

### Junior Assistant Scoutmaster duties:

- Function as an Assistant Scoutmaster (except for leadership responsibilities reserved for adults 18 and 21 years of age or older).
- Accomplish any duties assigned by the Scoutmaster.
- Regularly attends troop meetings, troop campouts, and troop events during his service period.
- Set a good example.
- Enthusiastically wear the Scout uniform correctly.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Show Scout spirit.
